Scholarship Application - 2018**

Requirements for Application:

1. The applicant must be a member of a family registered at St. Edith Stein Catholic Church of Katy, TX or a member of the Knights of Columbus Council No.12955; including members of the immediate family (wife, son, or daughter) of a Knight who is a member of the council. The recipients of a Scholarship in the previous year are ineligible this year. This allows us to help more young people.
2. The applicant must, prior to the award of the scholarship, be accepted for the Fall Semester as a FULL-TIME (12 credit hours) student at an accredited junior college, an accredited four-year college, or a post high school technical school. **Current college students, medical students, etc. are eligible to apply.**
3. **One original and four copies of the completed application (including copies of high school/college transcripts) must be received at the St. Edith Stein Catholic Church office by Friday, May 4, 2018 by 12:00 p.m. (noon). No applications will be accepted after this time.**

APPLICANTS: REQUEST TRANSCRIPTS NOW - THEY CAN TAKE UP TO SIX WEEKS TO OBTAIN.

4. The applicants are required to attend a 20-minute interview at St. Edith Stein Catholic Church in late May. **The Scholarship Committee will contact those applicants selected for interviews to schedule the time and room location.**
